Vancouver's West End is a fantastic neighbourhood, home to three great commercial streets, Davie, Denman and Robson, high density residential dwellings, gorgeous sandy beaches, stunning parks, hotels, shopping, bars, pubs, nightlife, and a wide range of restaurants serving cuisine from around the world.




Davie Village

Considered by many to be the heart of


Vancouver's gay community, this thriving neighbourhood offers a wide range of reasonably priced unique restaurants, bars and pubs, hotels and spas, specialty shops, bookstores, and more. Of course there have been many changes over the past few years due to the pandemic, but with restrictions finally over, the village is thriving once again. The expanded outdoor patios that resulted from these changes continue to be a colourful and lively addition to the Davie streetscape in 2023.



Ongoing enhancements include the now world-famous rainbow crosswalks at the corner of Bute & Davie, and colourful strings of LED street lighting, which make for unique selfies and photo ops. The retro Davie Village sign, located beside the Community Gardens near the east village entrance on Davie Street is another fab photo op, for visitors to the village.

Jim Deva Plaza, the 2.3 million dollar public space in the heart of Davie Village, is a community serving gathering space and home to a variety of events and activities, year round. This hub for the LGBTQ2+community, Jim Deva Plaza is a living memorial to the late Jim Deva, one of Vancouver's best known gay pioneers and heroes, located just half a block from his beloved Little Sister's Book & Art Emporium. A colourful special speaker's corner is also a fitting tribute to Jim.



Stanley Park

Gorgeous beaches, fabulous mountain backdrops, stunning city views, year-round gardens, and many attractions of interest, are just some of the reasons Stanley Park is destination for LGBTQ2+ popular Vancouverites visitors and alike. Twenty-seven kilometers of forest trails crisscross this amazing park, making for a seemingly out-of-the-way hike, within a major urban setting. Many have also chosen to exchange vows in the park, whether with a small outdoor ceremony by the sea, or a full-service catered event with all the trimmings.

Highlights of the 1001 acre park include the stunning 8.8 km Seawall around the park, The Vancouver Aquarium, Lost Lagoon, First Nations Totem Poles, Second Beach Pool,

Third Beach, Beaver Lake, Lions Gate Bridge, The Stanley Park Miniature Train, Stanley Park Horse Drawn Tours, Theatre Under The Stars, Brockton Athletic Fields, Pitch and Put, Brockton Point Cricket Club, The Vancouver Rowing Club, the Royal Vancouver Yacht Club, Stanley Park Pavilion and more.

Tall Douglas Fir, Western Red Cedar and Sitka Spruce are among the magnificent tree species that give a natural feel to this urban oasis. Garden enthusiasts can also enjoy spectacular Rhododendron and Azalea hybrids in the Ted and Mary Greig Rhododendron Garden and the Stanley Park Rose Garden right next to the Stanley Park Pavilion is a must see.

A relatively small, but active LGBTQ2+ nightlife scene includes one main nightclub, Paparazzi, as well as an LGBTQ2+ lounge, Friends of Dorothy, which serves food and hosts events in the downtown core. Other venues are LGBTQ2+ friendly and host occasional events throughout the year.


Pride festivities in Victoria span over ten days, including a colourful parade with over 100 entries, and a large outdoor festival, with vendor booths, beer gardens, and live performance stages. A year-round calendar events include community events,



fundraisers, theatre, drag extravaganzas, and more. This year Pride events kick off on June 29 with the Youth Pride Kick-Off Party, followed by the Memorial Drag Ball Game July 1, Big Gay Dog Walk July 6, Pride in the Word July 8, and the Pride Parade and Festival on Sunday July 9, as they celebrate 30 years of Pride in 2023.
